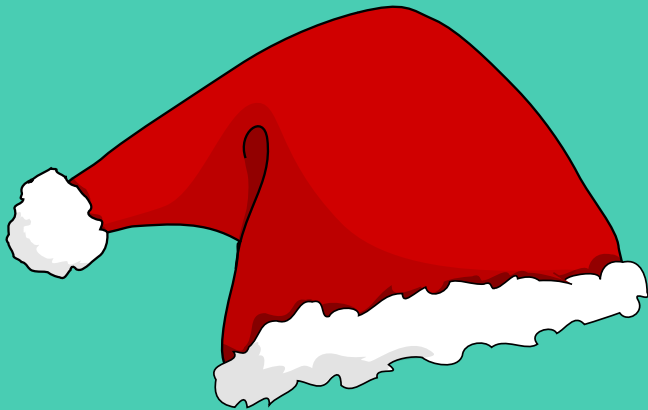

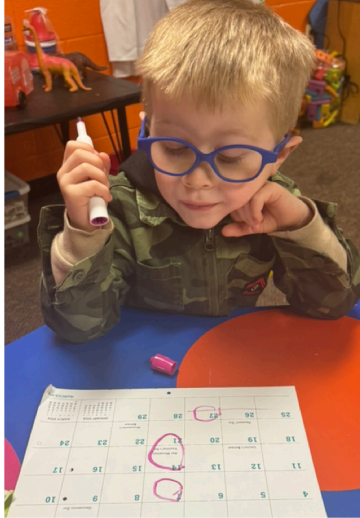
In November our crafts included making an owl and a turkey. We hope you liked them! I hope everyone enjoyed their Thanksgiving with family and friends.
