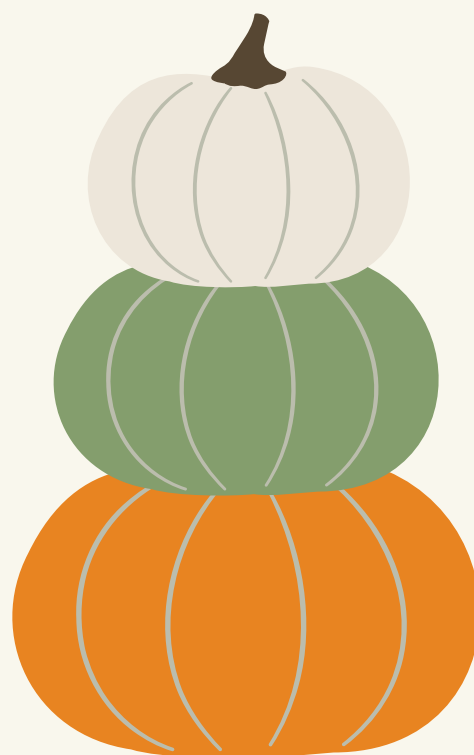

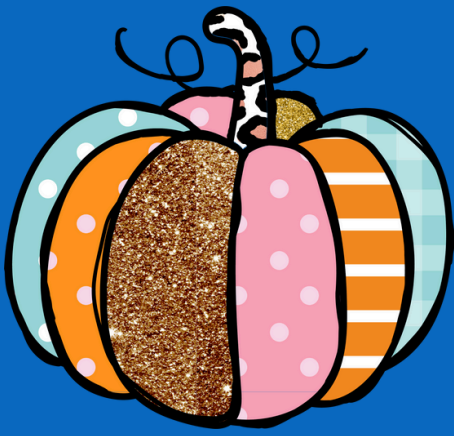
Fall Spirit Month: October
